

General safety



The company premises of Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH are **not open to the public**. Industrial trucks and rail traffic always have priority. Driving on the site is **at your own risk**. In the vicinity of crane systems, **special caution and helmet requirements apply**. It is strictly forbidden to stand under suspended loads. After leaving vehicles or buildings, it is mandatory to **wear high-visibility clothing**.



There is a **general ban on alcohol, drugs or other intoxicating substances**. Smoking, fire and naked lights are prohibited in the entire area. There is a **risk of slipping and tripping** (rail tracks, bumps, etc.)



A maximum speed of 30 km/h applies on the entire company premises. The **flashing lights must be switched on** while driving. The parking of vehicles is only permitted in **designated parking areas**. The Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH reserves the right to have vehicles removed for a fee if they have been parked contrary to the instructions, if they impede terminal operations or pose any other risk.



No photos or videos may be taken within the ISPS area. All types of misuse will be prosecuted. Each person must register before entering the ISPS area. **Admission privileges** are issued on a person-by-person basis only and **cannot be transferred or extended**. When persons are brought in vehicles, all occupants are subject to registration



Each vehicle must independently trigger the barrier opening at the ISPS terminal. Driving in behind vehicles in front is an access violation and will be prosecuted.

First aid, fire protection, escape and rescue routes



In case of danger, go to the assembly point in front of the buildings. In the event of an accident or injury, please speak to the nearest employee or call the emergency service on 112. The first aid facilities are i.e. in buildings and are marked with corresponding symbol boards.



Escape plans and instructions must be followed. Always keep traffic routes, escape and rescue routes clear. Do not block or obstruct emergency exits.

Safety signs



Please note the signs indicating dangers, prohibitions and requirements.

Blue mandatory signs stipulate certain behavior, e.g. wearing head protection.



Prohibition signs crossed out with a red line prohibit behavior that could result in danger, e.g. smoking.



Yellow warning signs warn of a risk or danger, e.g. industrial trucks



Green escape signs indicate an escape route or emergency exits, the way to a first aid facility or a first aid kit location.

Red fire protection signs indicate the locations of fire alarm and fire extinguishing systems.



Hazard symbols indicate a hazard characteristic of a dangerous substance, e.g. toxicity. Only instructed persons are allowed to stay in areas with hazardous substances.



Environmental protection and disposal



Avoid any environmental pollution from wastes or operating and hazardous substances. Please contact the next employee or Port Security if you notice anything pollution or spill.

The waste bins are to be used for household and non-industrial waste. Any unauthorized disposal of industrial waste will be prosecuted and punished.

The importation or introduction of hazardous substances into the port area requires prior written notification to the hazardous substances officer.



Regulations to contain the SARS-COV2 pandemic



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the current measures of the federal government, the state of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania and the district of Western Pomerania-Rügen must be observed and complied with.

In all buildings and closed areas of the Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH the obligation to wear a mouth and nose protection applies. The generally applicable minimum distance of 1.5 m must be observed.

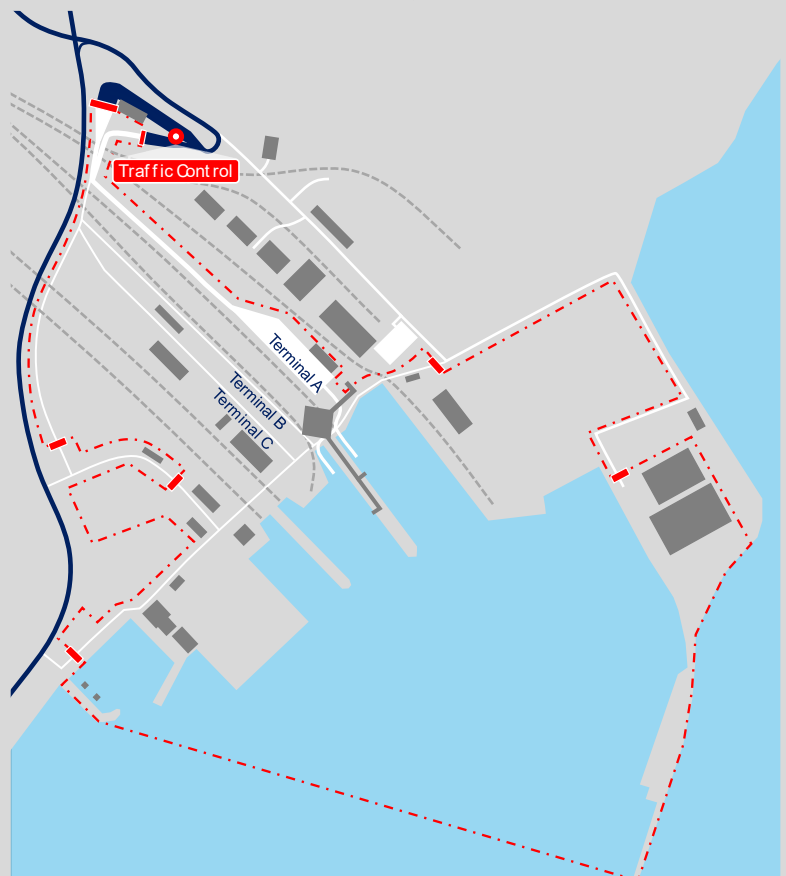
If you have symptoms that indicate a SARS-COV2 infection, you must leave the Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH site immediately.

Security and access control

Visitors and external companies are only allowed access to the company premises under the following conditions



1. Acceptance of the regulations listed on the instruction sheet confirmed by signature.
2. Access is only granted after approval by the security personnel; there is no general right of access for visitors to the terminal or the ship.
3. Wearing a helmet and reflective vest is compulsory in some areas. If required, you can borrow them from the security staff on deposit of your identity card or driver's license.
4. Unauthorized entry into sections, buildings or facilities is strictly prohibited.
5. The recording of audio or video documents is prohibited in the entire port area.
6. The instructions of the port staff must be followed.
7. Access authorization is only granted to individuals and cannot be transferred or extended. When passengers are taken in vehicles, all occupants are subject to the obligation to register.
8. Each vehicle must independently trigger the barrier opening at the ISPS terminal. Driving in behind vehicles in front is an access violation and will be prosecuted.
